When a community pulls together, amazing things happen!

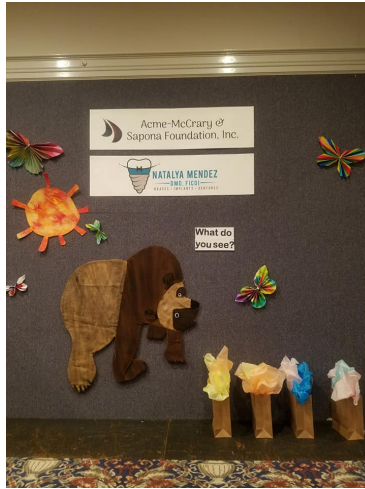
The Partnership's Gala for the Children, held on April 6, was a great success thanks to the efforts and generosity of many.

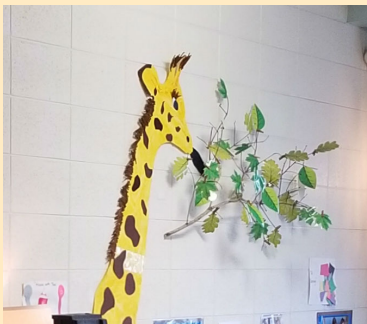

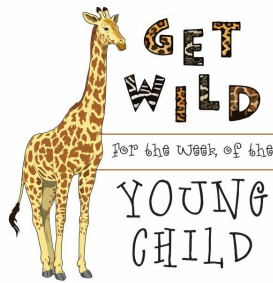

Each April, thousands of pinwheels are planted in Randolph County to promote awareness of child abuse and neglect during Child Abuse Prevention Awareness Month. Prevent Child Abuse America started the Pinwheels for Prevention campaign in 2008 to create a national effort to change the public's beliefs and behaviors regarding child abuse and neglect prevention. The pinwheel represents efforts to change the way our nation thinks about prevention, focusing on community activities and public policies that prioritize prevention right from the start to make sure child abuse and neglect never occur.

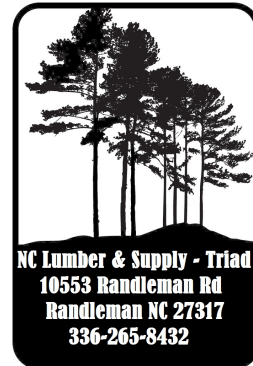
