A comparison to statistics from the 2018-2019 report illustrates the impact of the pandemic in the latter half of the fiscal year. But it also reveals the great work that continued to happen despite the pandemic.

We'd also like to point out that we ended the fiscal year with 3,608 children in Randolph County enrolled in Dolly Parton's Imagination Library—a 63% increase!
