## **Imagination Library Enrollment Climbing**



We currently have 4241 children enrolled in Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, or 53% of children under the age of 5 in Randolph County.

The Imagination Library sends a free book every month to enrolled children. The only eligibility requirement is that the child be younger than 5, because all children need books for a great foundation in early literacy.
