### 2021 Randolph County Family Survey live through Nov. 12

*Families with children birth-5 encouraged to complete survey*

**ASHEBORO, N.C. (September 29, 2021)** — The Randolph County Family Engagement and Leadership Coalition (FELC), which is facilitated by Randolph Partnership for Children (RPC), launched its annual Family Survey on Sept. 22. Families with children ages birth to 5 who live in Randolph County are encouraged to complete the survey before it closes on Nov. 12.

This is the third year FELC has conducted the survey, which was created to provide families with young children (birth-5) in Randolph County a way to share concerns, obstacles, and other important information to local organizations who provide services and support. The survey is conducted during the fall and can be completely anonymously. The congregate data is shared with agencies for the purpose of improving services and support to young children and their families.



“This year’s goal is to collect 750 responses,” FELC Co-Chair Jamee Tate said. “Last year we had less than 40, but we blame COVID for that. We’ve already received more than 50 responses this year, so we’re off to a good start. But we need a lot more.”

“We really want parents’ voices heard and to make changes that benefit families with young children,” Tate said. “When you have babies in the house, you need support. Parents need to know what’s out there to help and how to access it. We’re trying to make that easier.”
