

Family Survey 2024



At Randolph Partnership for Children, we're committed to supporting families across our community. This year, we launched a family survey to learn more about the families we serve and identify opportunities to better meet their needs. The survey was shared through newsletters, social media, and QR codes distributed during local parades, resulting in 15 responses filled with valuable insights.

Here's what we learned:


- **Zip Codes**: Families from across Randolph County participated (and few from outside), with the majority residing in Asheboro.
- **Family Size**: Most respondents reported having family size of 4, but answered ranged from 3-7.
- Child Care Situation: About 1/3 of families said their children are currently enrolled in child care programs. This was closely followed by reliance on family, friends, or neighbors.


This feedback provides a clearer picture of the families in our community and helps us ensure our programs and resources address their needs effectively.

Together!


